

## English

In English the children will be learning to;

- Use clear finger spaces between each word.
- Join words and clauses using 'and'.
- Structure and form a sentence with a full stop and capital letter.
- Speak audibly in front of small audiences.
- Recognise and join in with predictable phrases.
- Say out loud and form sentences about what they are going to write.
- Sit correctly at a table, holding a pencil comfortably and forming lower case and Capital letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the correct place.
- Link what they read or hear to their own experiences.
- Discuss the significance of titles and events in books.

*This will be taught through a range of fiction and non-fiction writing and story based activities.*

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- In Phonics sessions the children will revise phase 3 & 4 sounds, learning how to recognise and blend them.
  - All Children will also participate in daily,

## Maths

In Maths the children will be learning to;

- Partition numbers into tens and units.
- Count, read and write numbers in words and numerals to 20.
- Identify one more and one less of numbers to 20.
- Compare, describe, and solve practical problems for length, mass, and capacity.
- Solve addition and subtraction problems using practical resources.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts to 20.
- Recognise and name common 2d and 3d shapes.
- Sequence events in chronological order using time language.
- Recognise and use language relating to the date, including days of the week and months of the year.

## Science

In Science the children will be learning to;

- Ask simple questions.
- Observe closely, using simple equipment.
- Identify and classify.

*This will be learnt through observing and describing weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.*



## Computing

Children will be learning to:

- Use technology safely and respectfully.
- Use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs
- Identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content on the internet or other online technology.

## Art & Design Technology

In Art the children will be learning to;

- Draw and paint to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination.
- Develop techniques in using colour, form and space, i.e. primary and secondary colours, thick and thin brushes.
- Describe what they can see and like in the work of a famous artist. (Andy Warhol).

In Design & Technology the children will 'design and make' using a range of materials, including food. They will talk about their ideas, discussing what they like and dislike.



## PSHE

"New Beginnings"

Children will be learning to;

- Identify different emotions, and learn strategies for calming down when they feel angry.
- Work effectively as part of a team.
- Recognise what qualities are important in a friendship.
- Create rules for their classroom.

The children will be learning to;

- Be confident and safe in the spaces used to play games.

## Geography

- Identify the characteristics of the four seasons and understand their cycle throughout the year.
- Discuss weather patterns in each season.
- Identify deciduous and evergreen trees.

With a focus on the season of Autumn, children will learn about how the weather effects our daily lives and environment.

## Religious Education (R.E)

Children will be learning about the traditions of Hindus by;
