

Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs)

Year 2 Spring 1 – Multiplication and Division



Each half term we will be sending home mathematical recall facts. The goal is to recall these instantly resulting in a stronger foundation of mathematical knowledge.

The next of these is multiplication and division facts for the 2 times table.

Start with multiplication and move on to the division when ready.

Top Tips

- Do them little and often. See how many you can do over breakfast or on the way to school
- Create a poster and put it up somewhere you can see every day
- Making groups of objects will help make it visual
- Use games – Google multiplication/division games
- Do not try and learn them all at once

If your child is confident with their 2 and 10 multiplication and division facts then they can move onto the 3, 4, and 5.

$2 \times 1 = 2$

$2 \times 2 = 4$

$2 \times 3 = 6$

$2 \times 4 = 8$

$2 \times 5 = 10$

$2 \times 6 = 12$

$2 \times 7 = 14$

$2 \times 8 = 16$

$2 \times 9 = 18$

$2 \times 10 = 20$

$2 \times 11 = 22$

$2 \times 12 = 24$

$2 \div 2 = 1$

$4 \div 2 = 2$

$6 \div 2 = 3$

$8 \div 2 = 4$

$10 \div 2 = 5$

$12 \div 2 = 6$

$14 \div 2 = 7$

$16 \div 2 = 8$

$18 \div 2 = 9$

$20 \div 2 = 10$

$22 \div 2 = 11$

$24 \div 2 = 12$
