Your child can perform as an individual, or can work with friends within their own class bubble. Unfortunately, this year we are unable to allow children to perform with children from different classes or year groups.

There will be an 'audition day' on Wednesday 23rd June. On this day all items your child needs MUST be brought to school in a named plastic bag and kept on their peg. Your child will then need to feel confident enough to perform their piece in front of their class teacher on this day.

Please ensure all CDs can be played on a CD player or through a computer and contain age-appropriate lyrics. For security reasons, we are unable to accept music on a USB or any other portable storage device.
