If you do need any more ideas, or if you have any questions, please speak to your child's class teacher. We encourage the children to use their 'creative' super skill in order to design their costume themselves and to make use of everyday materials which you can find at home such as: silver foil, plastic bottles, newspaper and junk modelling items. The creation of their costume will also form part of your child's home learning challenge for the next week, leading up to 'Intergalactic Day'.
