Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 2 Trip to Natural History Museum

This year, Year Two have covered different topics such as 'Dinosaurs' and 'Endangered Animals', and their topic for the next half term will be 'Extreme Earth.' To support their understanding of these topics, we have organised trips for all of our Year Two children to visit the **Natural History Museum**. Children will be learning about natural disasters such as volcanoes and earthquakes, dinosaur fossils and animal species that are now extinct.

Class 9 will be visiting the Natural History Museum on Tuesday 23rd April

Class 8 will be visiting the Natural History Museum on Wednesday 1st May

Class 7 will be visiting the Natural History Museum on Thursday 2nd May

Each class will be travelling to the museum via **public transport** so please ensure your child arrives at school **promptly** at **9.00am** to allow us sufficient time to catch our train. The trip will take place during normal school hours – children will return to school by 3.30pm.

Uniform

All children should wear their **full school uniform**, **comfortable shoes** and a **lightweight**, **weather appropriate jacket or coat**.

Consent

Please use the online Teachers2Parents form to give consent for your child to attend the trip on or before <u>Friday</u> 22nd March.

Packed lunches

Children will need to bring their own **packed lunch** including a small bottle of still water in a lightweight backpack so that they are able to participate fully in the day's activities. If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for you child, please order one via the Teachers2Parents online consent form. All requests for a packed lunch provided by the school must be received by <u>Friday 22nd March</u> so that the school kitchen can order the appropriate amount of food. Unfortunately, the school kitchen is unable to fulfil any 'on the day' requests for a packed lunch. As with all school meals, there is no charge to parents and carers for a school packed lunch.

Contributions via ParentPay

To cover the cost of the visit to Natural History Museum we are asking for a <u>contribution of £6 per child.</u> This payment item will be available from 11th April on ParentPay. Please make this payment via ParentPay on or before <u>Monday 22nd April.</u> If there is any reason why you are unable to fully meet the cost of this trip but you would still like your child to attend, please speak to a member of the Headship team (each case will be dealt with confidentially, on an individual basis.)
