**Year 1 Trips to Morden Hall Park**

To support their understanding of the topic 'Let It Grow' from Spring 2, Year One will be visiting **Morden Hall Park** to enjoy a walk through the park and take part in activities to learn about Mini beasts and River Dipping with led by a Park Explorer.

**Class 4** will be visiting Morden Hall Park on **Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May**

**Class 6** will be visiting the Morden Hall Park on **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May**

**Class 5** will be visiting the Morden Hall Park on **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> May**

We will be travelling to the park via public transport so please ensure your child arrives at school **promptly at 9.00am** to allow us sufficient time to catch our tram. The trip will take place during normal school hours – children will return to school by 3.30pm.

All children should wear their **full school uniform, comfortable shoes and a lightweight, weather appropriate jacket or coat.**

**Please use the Teachers2Parents form which has been sent to your email address to give consent for your child to attend this school trip before Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April**

To cover the cost of the Mini beast and River Dipping activities we are asking for a **contribution of £6.00 per child. Please make this payment via ParentPay on or before Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April.**

If there is any reason why you are unable to fully meet the cost of this trip but you would still like your child to attend, please speak to a member of the Headship team (each case will be dealt with confidentially, on an individual basis.)

Children will need to bring their own **packed lunch** including a small bottle of still water in a lightweight backpack so that they are able to participate fully in the day's activities.

If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch for you child, please order one using the Teachers2Parents form. **All requests for a packed lunch provided by the school must be received Friday 19<sup>th</sup> April** so that the school kitchen can order the appropriate amount of food. Unfortunately, the school kitchen is unable to fulfil any 'on the day' requests for a packed lunch. As with all school meals, there is no charge to parents and carers.
