EYFS Visits to Surrey Street Market

This half term your child has been learning about 'Food, Glorious Food!'. We have had lots of fun reading stories about fruit, vegetables and where our food comes from. Staff and children will be walking to the market in the centre of Croydon during school hours. They will be back in time for their usual school lunch.

Children will be purchasing fruit at the market. This will allow all children to experience 'hands on, real life' learning, involving money. The children will bring the fruit they have purchased back into the classroom and create delicious fruit kebabs, fruit salad and smoothies with their friends. There is no cost to these visits. Please do not send in any cash in your child's bookbag, the school will cover the cost of the purchases made at the market.

You must ensure that staff at our school are kept up to date with any allergy or dietary requirements that your child has.
